The time schedule on Fridays will be altered to accommodate Off-Balance Friday.

Juniors will take either English 12 honors OR AP English Language based on previous English work. Both English classes are a combination of juniors and seniors. When not in English, students will be in art.

ICS is working with FKCC to finalize plans for the marine science class to qualify as a dual enrollment class. Students must be dive certified to earn the college credit. Numerous dives will be required as part of the college credit. Students can earn from 4 – 8 credits (4 per semester) of college credit through this class if the proposal is accepted by FKCC. Students who can not participate in dive certification (based on health or finances) may still be able to participate in the ICS credited class.
