Dear Parents,

Welcome to Camp Eagle! We are very happy and honored that you have chosen us as your child's summer camp. Here are a few guidelines that will help our summer camp run a little smoother. Working together we can have a great summer!

Hours of operation are 7:45am – 5:30pm. There is a late pick-up fee of \$5.00 for the first 5 minutes, and \$5.00 for each additional minute following. Please be considerate and make sure your child is picked up on time. Tuition and all field trip monies are to be paid Monday morning upon arrival.

Pool Days: Our pool days are every Monday and Friday (unless otherwise noted). The bus will leave at 9:00 am on these days. Please have your child dressed in swimsuit with sunscreen applied BEFORE arriving at camp. Your child should bring a change of clothes, towel, and picnic lunch. A small bag (provided in your registration fee) to hold the change of clothes works very well (easy to carry and keep up with, especially for the younger ones).

Lunches: Please remember not to pack heat-ups on Mondays, Wednesdays or Fridays as we are off property these days.

Storm Notice: Hopefully we won't have to use this, but in case of a storm, Camp Eagle will close along with Monroe County government/school closings. Please stay tuned to local radio and TV listings during storm times.

Field Trips: Field trip money is due on Monday of the week of the field trip along with tuition. This helps us know our exact count for the Wednesday trip. Please have your child dressed in Camp Eagle t-shirt (provided in your registration fee) and refer to the list of things required on the field trip sheet. Also, we need you to arrive 15 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time in order for us to be able to leave on time. We will not be able to wait for late arrivals. The bus will leave at the stated time.

Water: Please pack at least one refillable water bottle a day for your child along with any juice or Gatorade. Summers are very hot and children become dehydrated very quickly.
